
"Famous First Facts, now in its seventh edition, was first published by editor Joseph Kane for H.W. Wilson in 1933. The sixth edition appeared in 2006 (see ARBA 2008, entry 26). The current edition has almost 8,000 entries, more than 100 illustrations, 4 indexes, and 16 chapters covering firsts in several arenas—scientific, medical, technological, political, legal, social, and financial from the colonial period to the present. Entries can be as short as a sentence, but most are several sentences in length.

The book begins with a preface, notes on how to use the book, and "Expanded Contents." Chapters are organized into alphabetized subsections; "firsts" in these subsections are presented in chronological order. The chapters are as follows: Arts and Entertainment, Business and Industry, Daily Life, Education, Engineering, Media and Communications, Medicine and Health, Military and War, Nature and Environment, Population and Settlement, Religion, Science and Technology, Society, Sports and Recreation, and Transportation. Four indexes—subject, index by years, index to personal names, and a geographical index—facilitate searches.
