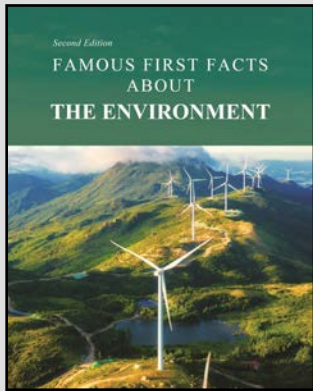

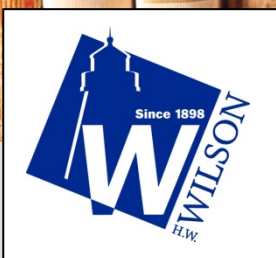

“From animal rights to zoos, this handbook presents exhaustive information about our environment, with over 150 themes covering every aspect of the environment you can think of plus lots more. The environmental contexts, both positive and negative, of a wide array of disciplines are all here, including activism, agriculture, art, forests, history, law, politics, storms, and warfare. Arranged within these wide-ranging topics are 4,500 granular, subject-specific entries such as ecofeminism, green politics, deforestation, fire prevention, rain forests, typhoons, ice, and tornadoes. Less obvious categories like species migration, genetic engineering, and literature are also examined, and contemporary developments like COVID-19 and AI are considered. A scattering of photographs adds drama to the text. Detailed indexes by subject, date, geography, and personal name enhance the serviceability of this source. **This is a nicely curated, specialized dictionary which will be suitable as a starting point for independent research and further study.
