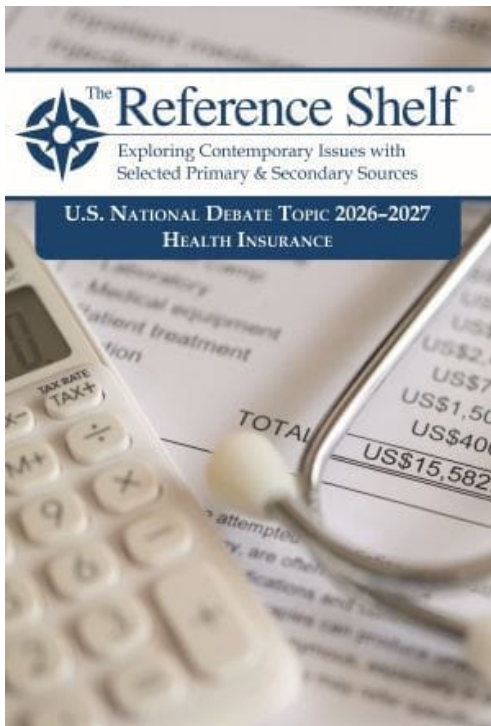

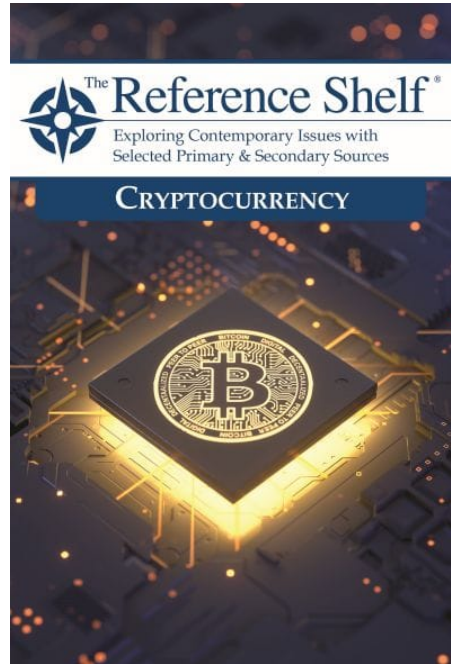
Cryptocurrency
