Each laureate, even if part of a two or three person winning team, has been given a separate profile. Although resulting in a certain amount of repetition in descriptions of joint work, this permits the reader to find in one place a unified account of an individual laureate's work.

Each article includes:

- Birth and death dates
- The category of prize he or she was awarded
- The name of any other individuals sharing the prize
- Bibliographies or further readings

The profile itself is written chronologically, with the following subheads: **Early Life and Education**; **Career**; and **Impact**. Readers will get a strong sense of the experiences and actions that led to this prestigious award, as well as accomplishments, both personally and professionally, following the win.

Finding information on the Nobel Laureates has never been easier. Researchers can trace the development of related achievements through cross-referencing of Laureates mentioned in profiles other than their own. They can also consult complete lists of Laureates organized by category, year, and country of residence.

Nobel Prize Winners includes information on how the Nobel Prize was established, the history of the Nobel Prize and Nobel institutions, and the process by which Laureates are selected and prizes awarded. You'll also find enlightening the biography of Alfred Nobel, who established the prize.
